

Potted Plants

Potted plants and indoor plants need particular attention. The nutritional requirements of a potted plant can be less than soil bound plants, however the loss of nutrients is often greater due to leaching through the pot. A regular, small dosage of fertilizer is far more effective than a large dose all at once. Care should be taken when fertilising potted plants as overdosing can cause burning to the plant relatively easily.

Indoor plants do not require much fertilizer and poor growth is generally unrelated to nutrition but linked others factors such as positioning and watering frequency.
